THIS WEEK'S LESSON: NEW ORDERS



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Although Paul had hoped to go on a mission to Asia, God gave him new orders to go to Macedonia. Because he obeyed, Paul met Lydia, a powerful woman. When Lydia heard Paul's message, she and all of her household put their faith in Jesus. Acts 16:6-15, Paul's Vision & Lydia's Conversion



THANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

How does your family typically handle a change in plans? Discuss with your kids how well or how poorly each of you reacts when plans are changed. Ask them why it's important to be open to change - especially when God is the one changing our plans.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why did Paul change his travel plans?
- What happened because Paul was willing to change plans?
- How do we know that God's plan is always the best plan?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse: "All things are possible with God." Mark 10:27b (NIrV)
